IAMAW MULTI-EMPLOYER PENSION FUND & RELEASE OF GROUP RRSP's

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

The IAMAW Multi-Employer Pension Plan contributions commenced on April 7, 2013. Anyone who has not yet completed an enrollment form needs to do so immediately and return them to the Local Lodge 16 offices. Enrollment forms are available from the Local Lodge website at iamaw16.ca, or by contacting the Local Lodge 16 offices, toll free at 1-877-303-0461 or 604-303-0461. If you do not provide an enrollment form, the Union will not have your Beneficiary instructions. Pension booklets are available at the Local Lodge 16 offices and have been sent to each base within the Region for distribution.

As previously advised employees who are 71 (seventy-one) years of age or older are ineligible to contribute towards Retirement Savings, according to Revenue Canada restrictions. Ineligible employees will continue to participate in a Guaranteed Investment Account (GIA) with G4S Secure Solutions.

The final remittance to the Group RRSP Plan has been remitted by G4S to RBC and processed into your individual accounts. The Group RRSP Plan will be de-grouped on June 3, 2013. Effective that date the withdrawal restrictions will be removed from the accounts and Members will have access to their funds, subject to the investment choices you made. Please refer to your individual quarterly statements from RBC to determine what investment choices you have made.

If you have funds in GICs that will be maturing at the end of June or if you have funds in savings exceeding \$1,000.00, we would strongly encourage you to make an appointment with an RBC Investment Officer at any branch prior to the end of June 2013 to reconfirm your investment choices.

Additionally, there are still Members that have not opened their Group RRSP accounts that the Union has received contributions for. If your pay statements reflect a contribution being made on your behalf and you have never received a quarterly statement from RBC or a tax receipt for filing with your income tax, then you have not opened your account. We will make one last attempt to contact Members who have failed to open their accounts. If accounts are not opened by June 14, 2013, the funds being held in trust will be turned over to the British Columbia Unclaimed Property Society.

Please be guided accordingly.
