Over the last few years, the IAM has made a concerted effort to invite our youngest members into the union process. We started with small focus groups, hosted a young worker symposium and in January of this year we conducted our first IAM Young Worker and Emerging Leader conference. Each of these events has helped to mold and direct our Young Machinists program. Survey response and feedback have been instrumental in crafting our next step.

Expansion of educational programs has consistently been at the top of every list when young workers are asked what they want. To fill that gap, we're adding a Young Workers Pilot Program to be held at the William W. Winpisinger Education and Technology Center in Hollywood, MD.
