#### Candidates for the G4S PACIFIC REGION NEGOTIATIONS COMMITTEE

- (1) NEGOTIATION COMMITTEE REPRESENTATIVE: Nominated/Elected from the Northern Bases, including Fort St. John and Prince George.
- (1) NEGOTIATION COMMITTEE REPRESENTATIVE: Nominated/Elected from the Island Bases, including Victoria, Nanaimo, Comox and Campbell River.
- (1) NEGOTIATION COMMITTEE REPRESENTATIVE: Nominated/Elected from the Interior Bases, including Kelowna, Penticton, Cranbrook and Castlegar.
- **(4)** NEGOTIATION COMMITTEE REPRESENTATIVE: Nominated/Elected from the Lower Mainland, including Vancouver.

All Nomination forms **MUST** be submitted in person or by registered mail to the **Recording Secretary of LL 16, IAMAW YVR Office Level 4 Domestic Terminal No Later than 15:00 pm on OCTOBER.2**<sup>ND</sup>, 2020

Both the **NOMINEE** and **NOMINATOR** must be "**Members in Good Standing**" of the Local Lodge for the nomination to be accepted. Nominees must be a "member in good standing" for at least one (1) year at the time of nomination for the nomination.

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic and the cancellation of several General Meetings, nominees and nominators do not have to meet the eligibility requirements concerning attendance of fifty percent (50%) of the Local Lodge monthly meetings.

### IAMAW CONSTITUTION - ARTICLE II - SECTION 3 - ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Members who reside in outlying Districts more than 25 miles from the designated balloting place, members who are either confined because of a verified illness or on leave qualifying under U.S. and Canadian family leave laws, or on vacation, or on official I.A.M. business approved by the Local Lodge or District Lodge or Grand Lodge, or on an employer travel assignment, or reserve military leave, as the case may be, shall be furnished absentee ballots. Members applying for an absentee ballot on the basis of residing in an outlying district more than 25 miles from the designated balloting place, shall have their eligibility to vote by absentee ballot determined by the Recording Secretary and the Secretary Treasurer before the ballot is mailed. Members found not to be eligible to vote by absentee ballot will be so notified within 10 days of the receipt of their application. Members who are delinquent in dues payments starting April 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 and extending through September 30<sup>th</sup> 2020 as a result of lay-off, please be advised that in consideration of the Coronavirus pandemic, your membership and voting rights have been extended through November, and not only for two months as set out in Article I, Section 14 of the IAM Constitution.

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic and safety of the membership, this <u>Election will be done through the Absentee Ballot Process ONLY.</u>

<u>ALL MEMBERS</u> are entitled to an Absentee Ballot and <u>MUST</u> request an Absentee Ballot in order to cast their vote.

Please fill out the attached Absentee Ballot Request Form and mail by Canada Post or hand delivered (Faxes not accepted) to the Recording Secretary of Local Lodge 16 no later than <a href="OCTOBER 2">OCTOBER 2">DOCTOBER 2">DOCTOBER 2"</a>, 2020 15:00 PM.
