The parties met in mediation on May 18, 30 & 31, 2022, to resume discussions in our continued effort to reach a tentative agreement that meets your needs. We requested a final offer from the Company, which included monetary that we could present to the membership, the Company declined to provide a final offer.

The CIRB has offered to mediate the parties, and we have agreed to meet independently with Lindsay Foley, Regional Director of the Canadian Industrial Relation Board (CIRB) on Monday, July 11, 2022, followed by joint mediation with the Company on July 12 & 13, 2022.

We will keep you informed of any changes in the status of collective bargaining following the mediation.

Thank you for your continued support, patience, and solidarity, but most of all, for your continued professionalism in preserving the safety and security of the public.
