## EMPLOYED AS SCREENING OFFICERS (PASS) LOCAL 16 – PACIFIC REGION COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UPDATE

Dear Members:

We met for direct bargaining January 14 – 16, 2025. Your Committee met internally on Tuesday, January 14, 2025 to review proposals and prepare responses. The parties discussed several outstanding non-monetary issues on Wednesday, January 15, 2025, related to grievance/arbitration procedures, transfers, shift trades/pick-ups & giveaways. On Thursday, January 16, 2025 in the afternoon, your Committee tabled a comprehensive monetary proposal package, following which we adjourned.

The parties are scheduled to resume direct bargaining on March 11 & 12, 2025 and expect to receive the employer's response to our monetary proposals. We are awaiting confirmation of additional dates in April 2025.

Your Committee continues to strive for an agreement that delivers the right protections on the job, fair wages, benefits, job security, and the RESPECT and DIGNITY you deserve. We are all in this together, and our strength at the bargaining table is dependent on membership support.

We want to remind you that the Collective Agreement continues to be in full force and effect and that during this time you are obliged to work under the conditions of the present Collective Agreement and should at all times comply with screening procedures and follow the CATSA issued SOP's.

Your Negotiations Committee thanks you for your continued support, patience and solidarity and commends you for your continued professionalism in preserving the safety and security of the public.

We will keep you apprised of any developments in the process.
