I.A.M. & A.W. CONSTITUTION - ARTICLE II – SECTION 3

Any member entitled to receive an absentee ballot shall make written request therefore to the R.S. of the L.L. by delivering in person, email or mailing such request to be received by the R.S. not later than 21 days before the election.
