1. An amendment to clarify a District 140 bylaw:

Moved that Under District 140 Bylaws, Article IV Conventions, section 4.06 be amended as follows:

“Local Lodge representation at District Lodge Conventions shall be based upon the following formula: (a) first 500 members - 2 delegates (b) each 500 members or major portion thereafter - 1 delegate. A major portion shall be defined as two hundred fifty-one (251) or more members.”

2. A new bylaw to make permanent the position of a Screener General Chairperson in the Western Region.

Moved that Article XI (Electoral Procedures and Qualifications for General Chairpersons) be amended by adding a new subsection (f) as follows:

“There shall be one (1) General Chairperson designated for Airport Screeners in the Western Region. This General Chairperson shall be nominated and elected solely by members employed as Airport Screeners in the Western Region.

Members represented by this General Chairperson shall not be eligible to vote for the Designated Service General Chairperson or the Designated Air Canada General Chairperson. Such members shall remain eligible to vote for all Western Region At-Large General Chairpersons.”

3. An addition to the District bylaws that introduces term limits for Constitutional Officers (i.e. their Executive Board).

Moved that Article V of the District 140 Bylaws be amended by adding a new Section 5.09, to read as follows:

“(a) No individual shall serve more than three (3) consecutive terms in the same District officer position. For the purposes of this section, service of more than one-half (1/2) of a term shall be deemed a full term.

(b) Following a break of at least one (1) full term from that same office, a former officer shall again be eligible to seek election to that position.

(c) This section shall not apply prospectively and shall not apply to terms served prior its adoption.

(d) This provision shall be interpreted and applied in a manner consistent with the IAM Constitution, and in the event of any conflict, the IAM Constitution shall prevail.
